The course is a brief, broad overview of the major theories of counseling and psychotherapy along with ethical and professional issues. Realities of current psychotherapy practice will be considered and opportunities to practice basic counseling skills are provided. The format includes lecture, discussion, reading and writing assignments, large and small group exercises and exams.

## Objectives:

- 1. An understanding of the major models of individual therapy.
- 2. An appreciation of how therapy facilitates change and growth.
- 3. An identification of factors that impact the counseling process.
- 4. Improved listening, communication and basic counseling skills.
- 5. Student self assessment of their abilities and interest in the field of psychotherapy.
