## **OVERVIEW OF RESEARCH AGENDA**

My research has focused on the racial experiences of youth. In particular, I examine how cultural strengths can be used to minimize the negative outcomes related to racism stress, violence and aggression, bullying and community stressors on health and academic outcomes. I have co-developed measurements of racial/ethnic socialization and developed assessments of racial cohesion and perceptions of same-race violence in the Black community and racial/ethnic socialization in White families. These culturally relevant measures ascertain how racial experiences influence youth health and academic outcomes. As a Robert Wood Johnson Foundation New Connection Scholar, I am studying the assessment, treatment and socialization processes of Black children that experience bullying.

### Overview of Teaching & Instruction

My teaching revolves around Developmental and Black Psychology, and in some classes, the fields directly intersect (ex. Lifespan Development of Black Women).
