Texas Child Study Center (TCSC)

History and Mission

Kevin Stark, Ph.D. and William Streussand, M.D. co-founded the TCSC on September 15th 2008. Currently, I am the Director of TCSC. The Center was formally recognized as a collaborative venture between the University of Texas at Austin and Seton Family of Hospitals (Managing partner of Dell Children's Medical Center) in a contract signed by the Presidents of both institutions in November of 2009. The Center represents the first formal collaboration between the University of Texas and Dell Children's Medical Center. The TCSC has as its mission: (1) Provision of state-of-the-art evidence-based mental health services for children, adolescents and their families; (2) Completion of cutting-edge research into evidence-based mental health practices; and (3) Training of mental health professionals.

The TCSC has grown into the outpatient treatment program for Dell Children's Medical Center (DCMC) and the psychological service provider for the patients in the DCMC. The Center has grown from a concept to a staff of ten licensed psychologists, two and three quarters board certified child and adolescent psychiatrists, two psychology post docs, four psychology interns, eleven psychiatry residents, and twenty doctoral students

from the Dept. of Ed. Psych. The office staff consists of four full-time employees. Total operating budget is \$2,100,000.00. As the Director of the Center, I manage the financial and clinical operations, complete clinical work with out patients and inpatients, conduct research, write grant proposals, assist other staff in writing proposal, participate in fundraising, manage the staff, prepare the budget and guide the growth of the Center.

Service to the Community

In the first 6 years of operations we have completed over 50,000 patient visits and worked with over 2,200 patients who may not have received services if the Center didn't exist. The TCSC provides a full range of psychological and psychiatric treatment and assessment services to the community, as well as neuro-psychological assessments, and assessment for autism spectrum disorders. The treatment procedures are completed within a multi-disciplinary model and utilize evidence-based practices.

Research

The professional staff is expected to conduct grant-supported research. To date research funding has been secured for the development of a measure for predicting which medical trauma patients are at risk for developing PTSD (\$80,000.00 in funding from Seton Family of Hospitals). Center received \$300,000.00 from the Shivers Foundation to support our neuropsychology clinic embedded in the Children's Cancer and Blood Disorders Center. We received a grant for \$250,000.00 from Hyundai.

Training

Each year we have between 6 and 12 Ph.D. students from the Department of Educational Psychology complete practicum courses at the Center. In addition, 8 to 11 psychiatric residents complete a one-year rotation at the Center. We have established a psychology internship program that was favorably reviewed for APA accreditation this year. We also established a psychology Post Doctoral Program.

Community Support

An endowment was established to support the Center's service activities. To date, the endowment stands at \$4,500,000,00
