<b>Critical dates for you to keep in mind:</b>	
<b>Aug 24 – Sept 14</b>	Arrange recommendation letters with faculty and others. Let them know there is a standardized form this year
<b>September/October</b>	Submit to APPIC your Match registration (after proposal)
<b>Sept 22</b>	Get packets of information to your recommendation letter writers (e.g., CV, what you are interested in, talking points)
<b>Oct 5</b>	Faculty members should have recommendation letters completed
<b>Oct 15</b>	Successful completion of your dissertation proposal meeting by this date. <b>Register for the match</b> after completion.
<b>Oct 17</b>	Submit portion of APPI that I need to approve (Summary of Doctoral Training, including hours, program info) before this date, along with updated strengths/weaknesses
<b>Nov 1</b>	Earliest internship application deadline
<b>December</b>	Internship interviews start. Most are in January
<b>Feb 1</b>	Submit rank order for the Match (Phase I). It would be smart to do this early (computers crash!)
<b>Feb 17</b>	APPIC Match Day, Phase I (official results of the Match released)
<b>Feb 23</b>	Application submission deadline, phase II
<b>March 13</b>	Submit rank order for the Match, phase II
<b>March 20</b>	APPIC Phase II Match day
<b>End of second summer session</b>	Last day to defend dissertation in order to get reduced registration costs (see SP Student Handbook)
